What is Wraparound?

Wraparound is a process for youth and their families to make their lives better! Wraparound is not something that families “do,” and it is not something that families are “given.” It is a commitment to family and team development with a never give up attitude.

Wraparound Process—

Engagement – building a relationship with family

Immediate Crisis Stabilization
– calming down the crisis

Strengths, Needs, Culture and Vision Discovery – identifying natural family strengths and the community services and support that will serve the best interests of the family

Building a Child and Family Team—

creating a team that helps support the family, such as friends, neighbors, faith-based supports, coaches, teachers and/or co-workers

Wraparound Plan Development –

working with the team to create a plan based on the family's strengths, needs and goals

Crisis and Safety Plan Development—developed as needed to support the family.

Transition and Commencement—helps families be prepared how to help themselves for the future.
